Canal warehouse, now BW office. EC19 with LC20 refurbishing. Coursed rubble stone. Hipped slate roof. Square plan. Three storeys. Canal elevation has central entrance and two windows to each floor; casements to ground and second storey and 4-paned sashes to first floor. First storey main entrance to south side, with concrete steps and steel handrails. Back elevation has left-hand side doorway, and two windows to first and second storey levels. All openings have segmental-arched stone heads and stone lintels. Iron crane bracket to south elevation.
