F Site Notes/List or Scheduling Description

Wharfside house. M-LC19. Yellow and red brick, rendered and painted white. Pitched slate roof with end ridge chimney stacks. Rectangular plan. Three storeys. Central ground entrance. Two windows to each storey. Wooden sashes with glazing bars to ground storey, replacement rectangular MC20 casements to first and second floor. Added rear projection. Brick with rendering and weather-boarding to second storey. Pitched slate roof. Modern casement windows. LC20 single storey addition facing canal, abutting side of house. Rubble stone with modern entrance and large casement window.

Forms spectacular grouping with Llanfoist boathouse, in steeply wooded setting and adjacent to the site of the former Hill's tramroad.
