Description:
House. Probably C19 but much altered. The south facade facing the canal is of rubble stone and 3 storeys under slate, with a lower modern extension to the left. The windows are modern but the openings probably original forming an irregular composition of five bays with the entrance door, but no windows, in the second bay from left side.

The wharf was formerly served by a branch of the 1812 Llanvihangel tramway between Govilon and Llanvihangel Crucorney. The wharf building originally extended as far as the canal edge at the terminus of the line, but this section is now absent.

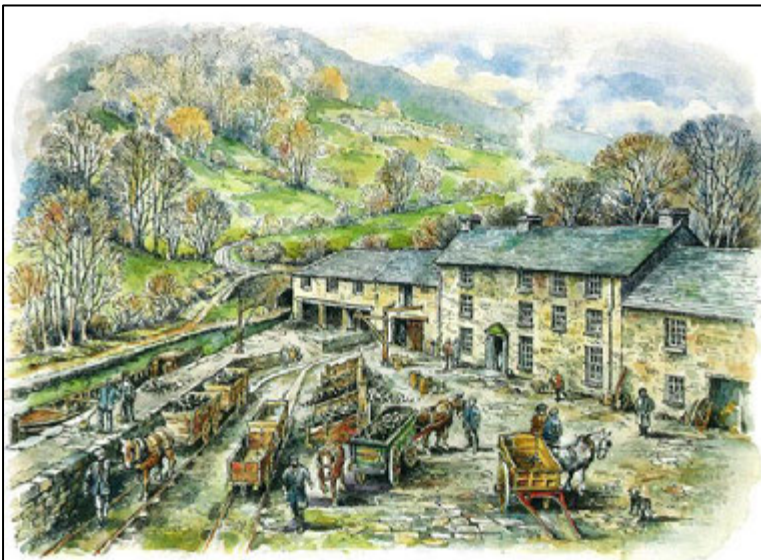
