A cobbled path is still visible near the modern steps to the manager's house (now a chandlers shop), and a large blocked arched opening is visible in the gable of the stables facing the canal."

Three bay rubble stone cottage under saddleback slate roof with end stacks, and attached stable range on same axis. Modern extensions for cafe, toilets and shop.
