F Site Notes/List or Scheduling Description

Canal cottage and stables, converted into shop, kitchen and toilet facilities. E-MC19 with later additions and alterations. Coursed rubble sandstone, rendered and painted white with a black plinth. Pitched slate and tiled roof. Two storeys. Rectangular plan; original cottage (now shop) with parallel stable extension. Front elevation; cottage has central entrance with porch, two six-paned windows to each storey, and central blind window. Stone gable chimneys, rebuilt. Left side of block is extension to the house, and has tie plate where internal wall separates house from stable. Irregularly spaced windows, LC20 casements with glazing bars. C20 rubble stone buttress adjacent to right window. Gable end shows trace of earlier segmental-arched opening, now with LC20 casement windows to ground and first storeys. Back elevation much altered, for toilet facilities. New house built as a cross wing at left end of old cottage. Brick, tiled roof with two storeys (not inspected as private property.)
