A very fine camp, at present much overgrown with trees and brambles. It is a circular earthwork, with a ditch 9 yards wide and 9 or 10 feet deep on the northern side. This ditch runs on after leaving the camp both on the eastern and western sides some 70 yards until it meets a steep natural declivity. On the east, too, there is a sharp natural fall. The western defence is strengthened by a little triangular outwork 17 yards by 30. It would seem as if there was no means of access from this position to the larger camp but through the ditch.
