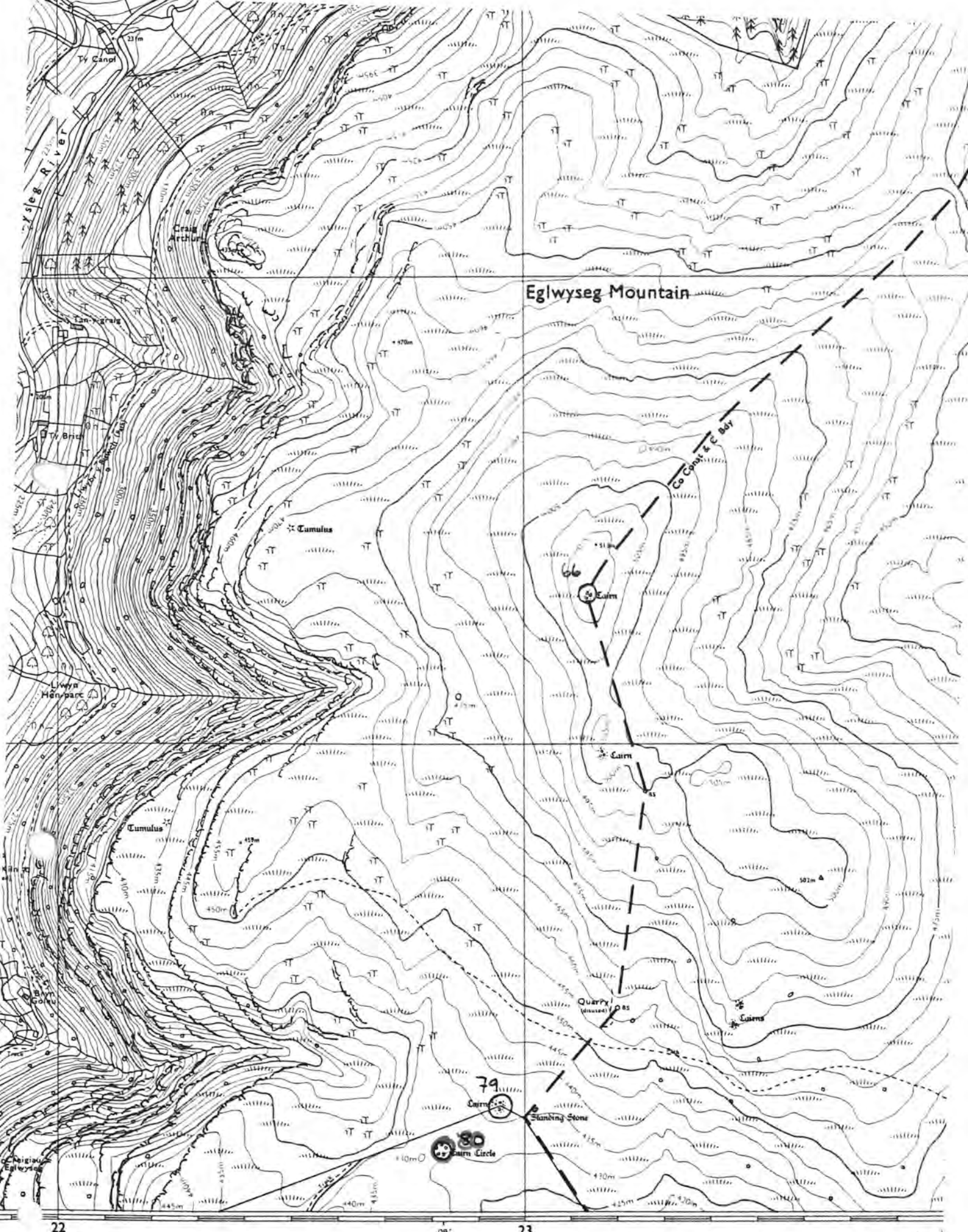

Description Text:

From Ellis Davies 1929:

This circle, which is about 16 paces across, has about 40 stones in, and close to, the periphery, and nearly 30 inside. Outside the stones forming the circle is a low bank of earth measuring about 54 paces around the outer side. When seen in 1920 the circle was nearly hidden by heather. In the summer of 1926, all the heather was cleared from the interior. In the autumn of 1927, the inside was quite bare and all the stones visible. The structure is evidently what is known as a 'cairn circle'.

From Clwyd Archaeological Record:

Eglwyseg Mountain Ring Cairn.

Form/Condition: Structure. Damaged

Site type/Period: Round Barrow. Bronze Age

Descriptive type: Stone setting. Undated

Drift/Solid Geology: No drift. Shale

Soil type: Peaty podzolic soils.

A ring cairn of a broken ring of large stones some 16m diameter surrounding a level interior with scattered stone. A hole in the centre could be a grave; the whole is much disturbed.

Lorna Bell's visit text:

The stone circle is composed of irregularly shaped boulders of conglomerate type. The circle measures 16 paces diameter and has a circumference of 54 paces. The interior is turf covered. There is a pit near the centre of the circle, which measures 1.4m across, and 0.2m in depth. The pit is turf covered. There are several small stones embedded in the turf around this pit. Mole hills are in evidence near the site, to the north east of the circle. A fenced ravine lies to the south east of the circle. To the west of the circle, there is a deep hole, where subsidence is taking place, 30 paces from the edge of the circle. The field surrounding the site is covered by thistles. The site is grazed by sheep. A light sheep track was in evidence across the interior of the circle; the turf however remained intact.

West of the stone circle, there are the remains of two cairns with a periphery of stone. The larger cairn measures 3.5m across. Each cairn is marked by a large stone. The cairns are situated on slightly higher ground, and are covered by turf.

Site as previously described on FMW visit, and under even turf coverage with sporadic patches of thistles and marsh grass. Interior marked by one small rodent burrow, and crossed by light sheep track impressed over turf.

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1999. The circle appeared to be unchanged from previous warden visits.

The stone circle is comprised of a number (c. 30?) of irregularly shaped stones, quite low lying but clearly visible above the short grass growing in and around it.

Not far to the west of the circle there are two small rings of stones. These have been recorded as possible kerb cairns during the recent Funerary and Ritual Survey (PRNs 101620 and 101700). The rings have few internal structures, and if they were cairns have evidently been robbed of much of their stone. It is possible that the more southerly of the two could have been used as a pen or shelter at some point.
