The site of the monument is shown on the attached map.





The remains of the wought iron railings have been removed from in front of the eastern face of the stone. Maen Huail is supported on a concrete plinth. The pavement surrounding the stone is composed of contemporary patterned brick. A plaque raised on the wall of the bank above the stone is easily discernible and reads: "Maen Huail " on which tradition states, King Arthur beheaded Huail, brother of Gildas the historian. The plaque is securely fastened to the timber fabric of the building.


